The Coordinator provides education, support and service coordination for families. This position is located at the NWCDC's community-based office in Vanderhoof and covers communities from Fraser Lake to Fort St. James.

- Sound knowledge of child development from birth to 6 years and experience working with children with support needs and their families.
