- To provide high level oversight of the use of the Society's assets, including approving the budget and the periodic monitoring of the organization's financial performance.
- To approve the strategic plan of the CDC.
- To recruit, supervise, retain, and evaluate the Executive Director.

Additional Roles

The Board of Directors have the following executive roles, Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Treasurer, Secretary.

The Board of Directors also participate on sub-committees, including Finance, Fundraising, Quality Assurance and Nominating Committee.





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Time Commitment

Depending on the Board of Director's level of interest and projects being worked on, typical Board of Directors will spend on average 15-25 hours per year on board related activities.
