The “CCRR Community Resource Consultant” will provide CCRR program services in the community of Hazelton, with travel required to the communities of Kispiox, Gitanmaax, Hagwilget, Kitwanga, Sik-E-Dakh, Gitanyow, and Gitsegukla. This includes child care referrals, as well as assisting families with the Affordable Child Care benefit. This position will provide program support including maintaining a community resource lending library, attending community information events, administration and assisting in the planning and implementation of CCRR service delivery and community development through the facilitation of drop-in programs, workshops and training venues and interactive support visits to childcare centres.

- 2-5 years of experience working with families in a variety of capacities.
- Ability to work with young children in a drop in program setting.
